1. One-Year Tenure Extension for Cabinet Secretary and Home Secretary: A Significant Decision for Administrative Continuity and Governance Reform

The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC), chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, has approved a one-year extension of tenure for Cabinet Secretary Dr. T.V. Somanathan and Union Home Secretary Govind Mohan. This decision aims to ensure administrative continuity, effective policy implementation, and stability in critical tasks related to national security. The ACC is the apex body of the Central Government responsible for decisions regarding the appointment, transfer, and service extension of senior officials.



2. Uttar Pradesh Private Business Park Development Scheme, 2025: A new initiative for world-class business parks and service-sector-led industrial development via the PPP model

The Uttar Pradesh Private Business Park Development Scheme, 2025, aims to provide world-class infrastructure to IT, GCC, AI, Fintech, and other knowledge-based industries by developing modern 'Plug-and-Play' business parks through the PPP model. Under this scheme, the government retains land ownership, while private developers handle development and operations based on the DBFOT model. Developers will be granted operational rights for 45 years, and the participation of major global companies as anchor tenants will be ensured.



3. Appointment of Tewolde GebreMariam as Air India's New CEO: A New Direction for Global Competitiveness and the Indian Civil Aviation Sector

The Tata Group-owned Air India has appointed Tewolde GebreMariam, the former CEO of Ethiopian Airlines, as its new Chief Executive Officer, succeeding Campbell Wilson. GebreMariam is renowned in the global aviation sector for his expertise in operational efficiency, fleet modernization, and successfully leading airline transformations. Under his leadership, Air India aims to expand its global network, enhance customer service, and establish India as a global aviation hub.



4. Randstad Employer Brand Research (REBR) 2026: Google Named India's Most Attractive Employer; A New Picture of Evolving Work Culture and Employment Trends

According to the Randstad Employer Brand Research (REBR) 2026, Google has emerged as India's most attractive employer, while the Tata Group and Amazon secured the second and third positions, respectively. The report indicates that Indian employees now prioritize factors beyond just salary—such as work-life balance, career growth, an inclusive work culture, and employee well-being. Notably, 46% of surveyed employees expressed a desire to switch jobs within the next six months, reflecting shifting employment trends.



5. SpaceX Falcon-9 Rocket Upper Stage Collides with the Moon: A Significant Event for Space Debris, Lunar Geology, and Future Space Missions

On August 5, 2026, the upper stage of a SpaceX Falcon-9 rocket—weighing approximately 4 tons—was projected to collide with the Moon near the Einstein Crater; official confirmation is still pending. This unplanned event occurred due to changes in the rocket's orbit caused by the gravitational influence of Earth and the Moon, as well as solar radiation. Scientists intend to use this event to conduct critical studies regarding the lunar surface, the resulting new crater, impact physics, and future lunar missions.



6. Massachusetts and Boston Declare August 15 as 'India Day': A New Recognition for the Indian Diaspora, Cultural Diplomacy, and India-US Relations

The US state of Massachusetts and the city of Boston have officially declared August 15 as "India Day," honoring India's 79th Independence Day and the contributions of the Indian-American community. This initiative will further strengthen India-US strategic, economic, educational, and cultural ties, as well as people-to-people connectivity. The declaration highlights the significant role played by the Indian diaspora in science, education, medicine, entrepreneurship, and public life, while also underscoring India's soft power.



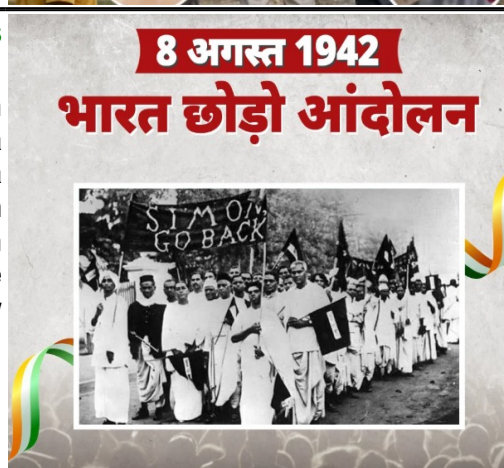
7. Centre's Proactive Action on Chandipura Virus (CHPV) Outbreak: Deployment of National Joint Outbreak Response Team (NJORT) and Strengthening of Public Health Surveillance

The Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has deployed a National Joint Outbreak Response Team (NJORT)—comprising experts from NCDC, ICMR, and DAHD—to Gujarat and Rajasthan to tackle the Chandipura virus (CHPV) outbreak. CHPV is an RNA virus transmitted primarily by sandflies; it can cause Acute Febrile Illness (AFI) and Acute Encephalitis Syndrome (AES), particularly in children. Several national institutes—including NIV, NIE, ICMR-NIVCR, and NIVEDI—are conducting collaborative research to study the virus's transmission, genetic structure, and effective control measures.



8. Quit India Movement Day (August 8): A Decisive Mass Movement in the Indian Freedom Struggle

Quit India Movement Day is observed annually on August 8, as it was on this day in 1942 that the 'Quit India' resolution was passed at the Gowalia Tank Maidan (now August Kranti Maidan) in Mumbai. Following Mahatma Gandhi's call of "Do or Die," a nationwide mass movement began on August 9, 1942, aimed at achieving complete independence from British rule. The failure of the Cripps Mission and the circumstances of the Second World War gave momentum to this movement, which saw widespread participation from students, farmers, laborers, and women.
