1. India to Host ICC Women's Champions Trophy 2027

The ICC has shifted the hosting rights for the 2027 Women's Champions Trophy from Sri Lanka to India. This inaugural edition of the tournament is scheduled to take place from February 14 to February 28, 2027. The hosting rights were moved due to concerns regarding government interference in Sri Lanka Cricket and issues related to ICC-mandated reforms. Six teams—Australia, England, India, New Zealand, South Africa, and Sri Lanka—will compete in a round-robin format. Matches in India will be held at the Cricket Club of India in Mumbai and the International Cricket Stadium in Vadodara.



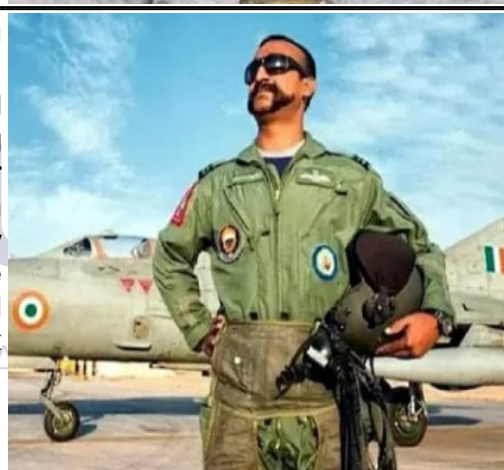
2. Tenzing Norgay National Adventure Award 2024

The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports has approved four recipients for the Tenzing Norgay National Adventure Award (TNNAA) 2024 in recognition of their outstanding contributions to adventure activities. Baljeet Kaur and Skalzang Rigzin have been selected for Land Adventure, Rimo Saha for Water Adventure, and Shiv Prasad Chamoli for Lifetime Achievement. The award is named after the renowned mountaineer Tenzing Norgay, who conquered Mount Everest alongside Edmund Hillary in 1953. Each awardee will receive ₹15 lakh, a statuette, and a certificate; the awards will be presented by the President at Rashtrapati Bhavan.



3. Group Captain Abhinandan Varthaman's Transition from Military to Civil Aviation

Indian Air Force Group Captain Abhinandan Varthaman has entered civil aviation as a pilot with the Goa-based regional airline FLY91 following nearly 22 years of military service. He gained national prominence after flying a MiG-21 Bison during the India-Pakistan aerial engagement on February 27, 2019, and being held captive in Pakistan for approximately three days. He was awarded the Vir Chakra—India's third-highest wartime gallantry award—in November 2021 for his bravery. FLY91 commenced operations in March 2024; by September 2026, its fleet is set to include six ATR 72-600 aircraft, with key bases in Goa and Hyderabad.



4. DRDO–University of Houston's BAM-H24 Patent — A Step Towards Indigenous High-Energy Propulsion Technology

Scientists from DRDO and the University of Houston have secured a patent for technology related to the high-energy compound BAM-H24, which holds promise for future solid rocket propulsion systems. Composed of boron, hydrogen, and nitrogen, BAM-H24 exhibits characteristics such as high chemical and thermal stability, resistance to impact and friction, and low moisture absorption. According to scientists, it offers the potential for superior specific impulse and reduced ignition delay, which could enhance propulsion efficiency and operational safety.



5. 'Tamil Nadu Olympic City' in Chennai — Boosting Sports Infrastructure

The Tamil Nadu government has unveiled plans to develop an international-standard 'Tamil Nadu Olympic City' in Chennai, to be executed by the SDAT. This integrated sports complex will feature world-class sports grounds, modern equipment, and facilities such as a High-Performance Training Centre. The project will also include a Sports Science Centre and a Sports Medicine Centre to assist with performance analysis, injury prevention, treatment, and recovery. The initiative aims to provide scientific training to athletes, strengthen sports infrastructure, and foster holistic athlete development for national and international competitions.



6. Lahore Named SCO Tourism and Cultural Capital 2026–27

Lahore has been designated as the SCO Tourism and Cultural Capital for 2026–27; this announcement was made during the SCO Heads of State meeting held in Bishkek. The initiative aims to foster tourism, cultural exchange, heritage preservation, and people-to-people contact among SCO member nations. During this period, Pakistan has assumed the SCO chairmanship, with the theme "Turning Vision into Action: Connectivity, Innovation, and Shared Prosperity." The SCO was established in 2001, and India became a full member in 2017; the organization currently comprises 10 member countries.



7. Establishment of Coconut Park in Kerala — Boosting Value Addition and Exports

The Kerala government, in collaboration with the Coconut Development Board, has announced the establishment of a Coconut Park in the state, aiming to boost processing, value addition, and exports within the coconut sector. The announcement was made during the national celebrations of World Coconut Day on September 2, 2026, with a focus on the entire value chain—from production to packaging, branding, and marketing. Through this park, efforts will be made to develop high-quality coconut-based products, increase farmers' income, and create opportunities for rural employment and entrepreneurship.



8. Teachers' Day — Honoring Education and Teachers in Memory of Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan

In India, Teachers' Day is celebrated annually on September 5th to mark the birth anniversary of Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan—a distinguished philosopher, educationist, and the second President of India. The tradition of celebrating Teachers' Day in India began in 1962, when Dr. Radhakrishnan suggested dedicating his birthday to honoring teachers. Teachers play a pivotal role in building human capital by fostering moral values, critical thinking, discipline, creativity, and a scientific temper among students. The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 emphasizes teacher training, continuous professional development, and student-centric education, thereby promoting quality learning outcomes.
